DRF/NTRA National Handicapping Championship Qualifier Turfway Park

Sunday, December 6

One day after Keeneland's qualifier—just 60 minutes away!

Top 3 finishers go to 'Vegas for the national contest!

Live bankroll. No mandatory races. Cash prizes to 10th place.



Date & Time: Sunday, December 6, 2009

Walk-up registration begins at 11:00am. First post 1:10pm.
All times Eastern.

Place: Turfway Park Terrace Room, 3rd floor. Seating is first come, first served.

Entry fee: \$150

\$48 is deposited to contest card as live bankroll; remainder applied to purses.

Cash, check, or credit card in advance. *Do not mail cash.*
Only cash or check at the door. Entry fees are not refundable. No limit on number of entries per person.

Entry includes buffet, two drink tickets, and handicapping resources. Limited AC outlets are available. Wi-Fi is available throughout the facility.

Format: All wagers are \$2 win and place. Players must wager \$2 to win and \$2 to place on each contest race. Players may use the same horse for both bets or choose one horse to win and another to place. Standings will be posted on selected video monitors.

Races in Play: Turfway Park management will designate a range of races from five tracks. Each player may play as many races as his/her bankroll allows but all must be

selected from among the designated races. Every effort will be made to include tracks in Kentucky, New York, Florida, Louisiana, and Illinois. There are no mandatory races.

The list of tracks and races will be posted at the FasTrack booth and turfway.com on Friday, December 4.

Scratches & Non-Starters: If a player's horse scratches, the wager may be changed before the start of the race. If the player fails to change the wager, a refund for that horse will be given *after* the race is official.

If the player's horse is declared a non-starter, the wager will be refunded after the race is official.

Prizes*: Placings are determined by *accumulated winnings*, not account balance. In case of a tie, the placing goes to the player with the greatest percentage of winners. All money left on the contest card may be cashed out *after the last race is official* and must be cashed out by 5:30pm December 6, 2009, or be forfeit. All decisions by Turfway Park management are final.

1st: \$7,500 and a spot in the national contest**
2nd: \$4,500 and a spot in the national contest**
3rd: \$2,500 and a spot in the national contest**
4th: \$1,000 • 5th: \$500 • 6th – 10th: \$300 each

*Payouts based on a minimum of 300 entries. **Players already qualified for the national tournament play for purse money only.
