

- **PICK 3 – 22% - CDRT Pick 3 Rule – 100% Payout (Consolation(s) allowed, approved by KHRC)**
 - ***NO WINNER:***
No bets on any winner in any leg: Pool Refund.
 - ***RACE(S) CANCELLED:***
If for any reason more than ½ of the races comprising the triple/pick 3 are cancelled the pool shall be refunded. (2 races cancelled trigger triple/pick 3 pool refund)
 - If any leg is cancelled or declared non-betting before the start of the first leg, the pool shall be refunded.
 - ***RACE(S) CANCELLED – LESS THAN 2:***
Payoff determined on contested leg(s).
 - If 1 of 3 races is cancelled the pool will pay the best of winners of 2 of 3 or 1 of 3.
 - ***PAYS:***
 - 3 of 3 – Pays 100% of the pool.
 - If less than 3 – Pays 100% of the pool.
 - ***OFF THE TURF:***
If the condition of the turf course warrants a change of racing surface in any races of the P3, and the change has not been disclosed to the public prior to off time of the first race of the P3, the stewards shall declare the changed races an all win race for P3 wagering purposes only. An all win race shall assign the winner of that race to each P3 ticket holder as their selection for that race.
 - ***SCRATCHES & CONSOLATIONS:***
 - ***REFUND*** - If scratch(s) occur prior to “official” of the 1st leg: all bets containing such scratch(s) will refund.
 - ***CONSOLATION*** - Scratch in 2nd leg, after the start of the 1st leg: Consolation payoff will be computed on bets combining the winner(s) of the 1st and 3rd leg with scratched horses.
 - ***CONSOLATION*** - Scratch in 3rd leg, after the start of the 1st leg: Consolation payoff will be computed on bets combining the winner(s) of the 1st and 2nd leg with scratched horses.
 - ***CONSOLATION*** - Scratch in 2nd and 3rd leg, after the start of the 1st leg: Consolation payoff will be computed on bets combining the winner(s) of the 1st leg with scratched horses.
 - ***DEAD HEAT:***
If there is a dead heat for first place involving two or more betting interest in an any of the P3 races, the pool shall be distributed as a profit split pool with each winning wager receiving an equal share of the profit.

- **PICK 4 – 22% - Section 14 Method 4 – 100% Payout**
 - ***NO WINNER:***
No bets on any winner in any leg: POOL REFUND.
 - ***RACE(S) CANCELLED:***
If for any reason more than ½ of the races comprising the pick 4 are cancelled the pool shall be refunded. (3 races cancelled trigger Pick 4 pool refund)
 - ***RACE(S) CANCELLED – LESS THAN 3:***
Payoff determined on contested leg(s).
 - If 1 of 4 races is cancelled, P4 pool will be split amongst the best of winners of 3 of 4 or 2 of 4 or 1 of 4.
 - If 2 of 4 races are cancelled, P4 pool will be split amongst the best of winners of 2 of 4 or 1 of 4.
 - ***PAYS:***
 - 4 of 4 – Pays 100% of day pool.
 - If less than 4 – Pays 100% of the pool.

- **OFF THE TURF:**
If the condition of the turf course warrants a change of racing surface in any races of the P4, and the change has not been disclosed to the public prior to off time of the first race of the P4, the stewards shall declare the changed races an all win race for P4 wagering purposes only. An all win race shall assign the winner of that race to each P4 ticket holder as their selection for that race.
 - **SCRATCH:**
A scratch in any leg, regardless of when the scratch occurred will result in the actual post time favorite for that leg being substituted for the scratched runner(s)
 - **DEAD HEAT:**
If there is a dead heat for first place involving two or more betting interest in an any of the P4 races, the pool shall be distributed as a single price pool with each winning wager receiving an equal share of the profit.
- **PICK 5 – 15% - Section 14 Method 1 With C/O 75/25 Split**
 - **NO WINNER:**
No bets on any winner in any leg: POOL REFUND.
 - **RACE(S) CANCELLED:**
If for any reason more than ½ of the races comprising the pick 5 are cancelled the pool shall be refunded. (3 races cancelled trigger pick 5 pool refund)
 - **RACE(S) CANCELLED – LESS THAN 3:**
Payoff determined on contested leg(s).
 - If 1 of 5 races is cancelled, carryover from any previous P5 will be carried forward. Day pool only will be split amongst the best of winners of 4 of 5 or 3 of 5 or 2 of 5 or 1 of 5.
 - If 2 of 5 races are cancelled, carryover from any previous P5 will be carried forward. Day pool only will be split amongst the best of winners of 3 of 5 or 2 of 5 or 1 of 5.
 - **PAYS:**
 - 5 of 5 – Pays 100% of day pool + any carryforward added from any previous pick 5.
 - If less than 5 – Pays 25% of the pool – **75% carried forward to the last pick 5 carded on the next business day.**
 - **OFF THE TURF:**
If the condition of the turf course warrants a change of racing surface in any races of the P5, and the change has not been disclosed to the public prior to off time of the first race of the P5, the stewards shall declare the changed races an all win race for P5 wagering purposes only. An all win race shall assign the winner of that race to each P5 ticket holder as their selection for that race.
 - **SCRATCH:**
A scratch in any leg, regardless of when the scratch occurred will result in the actual post time favorite for that leg being substituted for the scratched runner(s)
 - **DEAD HEAT:**
If there is a dead heat for first place involving two or more betting interest in an any of the P5 races, the pool shall be distributed as a single price pool with each winning wager receiving an equal share of the profit.
- **PICK 6 – 15% - Section 14 Method 7 With C/O 90/10 – Unique (Single Winner)**
 - **NO WINNER:**
No bets on any winner in any leg: POOL REFUND.
 - **RACE(S) CANCELLED:**
If for any reason more than ½ of the races comprising the pick 6 are cancelled the pool shall be refunded. (4 races cancelled trigger pick 6 pool refund)
 - **RACE(S) CANCELLED – LESS THAN 4:**
Payoff determined on contested leg(s).

- If 1 of 6 races is cancelled, carryover from any previous P6 will be carried forward. Day pool only will be split amongst winners of 5 of 6 or 4 of 6 or 3 of 6 or 2 of 6 or 1 of 6.
 - If 2 of 6 races are cancelled, carryover from any previous P6 will be carried forward. Day pool only will be split amongst winners of 4 of 6 or 3 of 5 or 2 of 6 or 1 of 6.
 - If 3 of 6 races are cancelled, carryover from any previous P6 will be carried forward. Day pool only will be split amongst winners of 3 of 6 or 2 of 6 or 1 of 6.
 - **PAYS:**
 - 6 of 6 (Single Winner) – Pays 100% of day pool + any carryforward added from any previous pick 6.
 - Multiple 6 of 6 (More Than 1) – Pays 90% of the day pool – 10% carried forward to the pick 6 of the next business day.
 - Less than 6 of 6 – 100% carryforward to the pick 6 of the next business day.
 - **OFF THE TURF:**

If the condition of the turf course warrants a change of racing surface in any races of the P6, and the change has not been disclosed to the public prior to off time of the first race of the P6, the stewards shall declare the changed races an all win race for P6 wagering purposes only. An all win race shall assign the winner of that race to each P6 ticket holder as their selection for that race.
 - **SCRATCH:**

A scratch in any leg, regardless of when the scratch occurred will result in the actual post time favorite for that leg being substituted for the scratched runner(s)
 - **DEAD HEAT:**

If there is a dead heat for first place involving two or more betting interest in an any of the P6 races, the pool shall be distributed as a single price pool with each winning wager receiving an equal share of the profit.
- **SUPER HIGH-5 – 22% - Section 11 With 100% C/O - Rolling**
 - **RACE CANCELLED:**

Pool Refund
 - **PAYS:**
 - First 5 finishers in exact order – Pays 100% of day pool + any carryforward added from any previous super high-5.
 - If there are no wagers sold selecting the first 5 finishers in the race in exact order, 100% of the day pool is carried forward to the next occurrence super high-5 in the current day race card. In the case of the last super high-5 of the current day race card, the carry forward will be moved to the first occurrence of the super high-5 of the next business day.
 - **SCRATCH:**

A scratch will result in a refund of all combinations involving the scratched runner(s).
 - **DEAD HEAT:**

If a dead heat occurs in any finishing position, all wagers selecting either of the runners in a dead heat with the correct runners not finishing in a dead heat shall be winners and share in the SH5 pool. Payouts shall be calculated by splitting the pool equally between each winning combination, then dividing each portion by the number of winning tickets.

REFUNDS ISSUED

If at any time our pools are removed from the merged pool totals of another hosts event refunds shall be issued on the affected pool(s) or race(s). An announcement must be made to the public as noted in the next section. Signs shall be posted throughout the building in public view stating that we will refund in the even we are excluded from a host tracks pools.

Cause for Public Announcement

In the event there are technical difficulties an announcement must be made over the PA system. Such events would include but not be limited to communication loss with the tote system. Any such event that impacts wagering for our patrons such as the removal of our wagers from the host track pool(s). **AT ANY TIME OUR POOLS FAIL TO TRANSFER IT WILL RESULT IN REFUNDS OF ALL WAGERS IN AFFECTED POOL(S) OR RACE(S).** Video should be contacted so they can put out a message on the TV screens throughout the building stating which race(s) are impacted and the action to be taken.

Title 810 Chapter 6 Regulation 030

Section 9.Sale of Pari-Mutuel Tickets on Live Horse Races.

(1)The following types of pari-mutuel wagering shall be permitted on a live horse race at all licensed associations and simulcast facilities:

- (a)Normal win, place, and show wagers on each race;
- (b)Any exotic wager previously approved by the corporation pursuant to 810 KAR 6:010; and
- (c)Any new exotic wager approved in writing by the corporation pursuant to KAR Title 810.

(2)Pari-mutuel tickets on live horse races shall not be sold except by a licensed association or a simulcast facility authorized by KRS 230.380.

(3)Pari-mutuel tickets on a live horse race shall only be sold at regular ticket windows, self-service totalizator machines, by mobile pari-mutuel tellers with hand-held totalizator devices, or by any other method approved in writing by the corporation prior to being offered to the public. At least one (1) regular ticket window shall be made accessible to handicapped patrons.

(4)(a)Pari-mutuel stored value cards or cash vouchers may be offered by an association. The dollar amount on the stored value card or cash voucher may be redeemed at any time at any regular ticket window, or used to fund additional wagers.

(b)Cash vouchers shall be valid for one (1) year after the date of issuance. Failure to present any cash voucher for redemption within one (1) year of issuance shall constitute a waiver of the right to receive payment on the voucher.

(5)A pari-mutuel wager shall not be made on a race after the totalizator has been locked for that race.

(6)Any claim by a patron that he or she has been issued a pari-mutuel ticket other than that requested shall be made before the patron has left the ticket window or before the mobile teller has initiated a transaction with another patron. A claim for an incorrect ticket shall not be honored after the totalizator has been locked.
